

### Notes from the Principal Mrs. Cassi Smith


#### Dear St. Patrick School Alumni

### I. YEAR ONE: 2023-2024

- 5. Planned giving focus: via mailings and/or on site.

#### III. YEAR THREE: 2025-2026

- 1. Continue communication outreach from Year One and Year Two.
- 2. Continue alumni organization committee meetings.
- 3. Continue annual alumni appeal/adopt-a-student.
- 4. Host an all-school alumni reunion or class reunions based upon Year One survey and ongoing feedback from alumni organizational committee.
