Application and Re-Enrollment for St. Patrick School

St. Patrick School is accepting applications and re-enrollment for the

2021-2022 school year. If you are interested in attending our wonderful school and are a family with a new student, you can begin the process by applying. Go to our school website at: https://school.stpatswashington.com/ Click on the "Admission" tab, select "Apply Online" and "Admissions Online". Please feel free to contact our school office for more information and answers to your questions or to schedule a tour of the school campus at 309-444-4345.

If you are a family re-enrolling, use your Parents Web account to login into Ren Web. The next step is to go to Apply/Enroll tab, then Enrollment/Re-enrollment tab. You can then begin your re-enrollment packet. Please feel free to contact our school office for more information or if you have questions at 309-444-4345.

Tuition will remain the same as the 2020-2021 school year. There will be a Technology Fee of \$150 per family to help begin replacement of ChromeBooks. This technology fee meets a direct student benefit and classroom need. ChromeBooks must meet current software requirements required to operate the programs and assessments used in our curriculum.

Enrollment/Reenrollment will begin on February 1st. Returning students need to re-enroll by February 15 and pay the \$100 registration fee (applied to their total tuition) to hold their place and avoid a late registration fee that is not applied to the total tuition.

Bus fees, milk fees, and Extended Care costs will remain the same as the 2020-2021 school year, too.

Tuition Assistance is available for qualifying students. First apply at https://empowerillinois.org/ and click on "Apply" to begin the process. Families interested in applying for tuition assistance from the Spalding Scholarship Fund must complete an online FACTS Grant & Aid Application at online.factsmgt.com/aid. The application and required supporting tax documents must be received online by FACTS by the application deadline date of April 30, 2021.

We look forward to re-enrolling all of our students and admission of new students and families to St. Patrick School.

Families Eligible for Active Parishioner Discounted Rate

- A registered family of St. Patrick Parish
- At least one parent or legal guardian being a baptized Catholic in good standing with the church or at least one parent or legal guardian being an active participant in the parish RCIA
- A regular attendee of weekend Vigil Mass or Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation
- Giving of time and talent, participating in at least one parish ministry or committee
- A contributor of treasure, beyond tuition, to the parish according to the means of the family

Families Charged the Cost to Educate (CTE)

- Catholic non-parishioners
 - Note: Catholic non-parishioners can request tuition support from their own parish to offset a portion of the full CTE tuition rate.

Payment Information

- Tuition, before/after care, and bus rates approved by the parish Finance Council after careful analysis, dialogue, and review and in collaboration with school administration. There is no change in the tuition for the 2021-2022 school year. Tuition will remain the same as 2020-2021. Extended care before/after school, and bus rates remain the same for 2021-2022 school year. However, a Technology fee of \$150 per family will be implemented to help begin replacement of ChromeBooks. This technology meets a direct student benefit and classroom need. ChromeBooks must meet current software requirements required to operate the programs and assessments used in the curriculum. It is important for us to keep tuition and other school programs affordable while continuing to provide and enhance our outstanding Catholic Education curriculum and programs. Included in this document is the cost to educate each student at St. Patrick School and the amount the Parish subsidizes for each student.
- These rates apply to active, participating, contributing members of St. Patrick Parish. Non-active, non-participating, non-contributing families will be charged the non-parishioner rates.
- The multi-student discount applies to Grades K-8 only. Our Preschool Program is self-funding.
- Option 1 is a single payment made by cash or check on or before July 1st. (Full amount less the pre-paid registration fee.)
- Option 2 is a twice yearly payment made by automatic withdrawal July 1st and the following January 1st. (One-half tuition amount less pre-paid registration fee).
- Options 3 and 4 are monthly plans processed through FACTS on the 10th or the 20th of the month as an automatic withdrawal from your checking or savings account. The necessary documentation has been included in your registration packet.
- A \$25 late fee will be assessed for any payment received after the due date.

Registration Fee

- A \$100 non-refundable registration fee is required at the time of registration at the parish business office.
- This fee is **per student**.
- This fee is applied to the total tuition bill.
- A late registration fee of \$100 per student will be charged if enrollment is not completed within the two week period of open enrollment. This fee is not refunded or applied to tuition.
- The Technology fee is applied to the total tuition bill and is \$150 per family.
- Re-enrollment registration period will be February 1-February 15.
