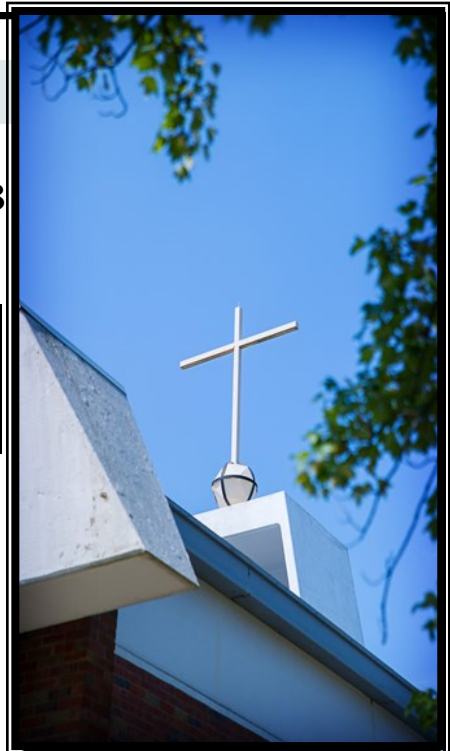

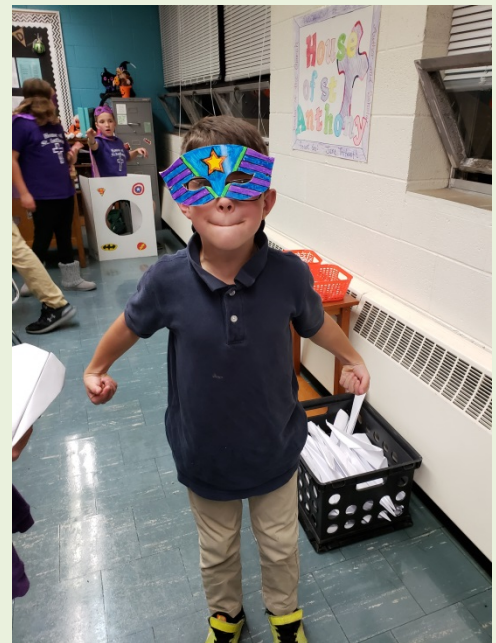

Thursday, October 25th- Red Ribbon Gift!

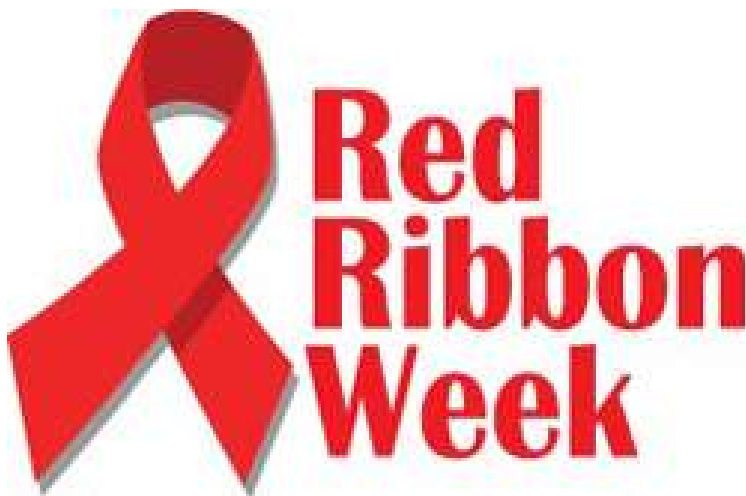
- Students will also receive a Red Ribbon themed gift!

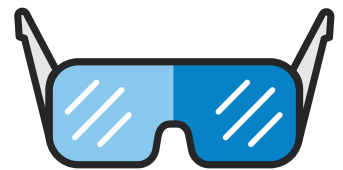

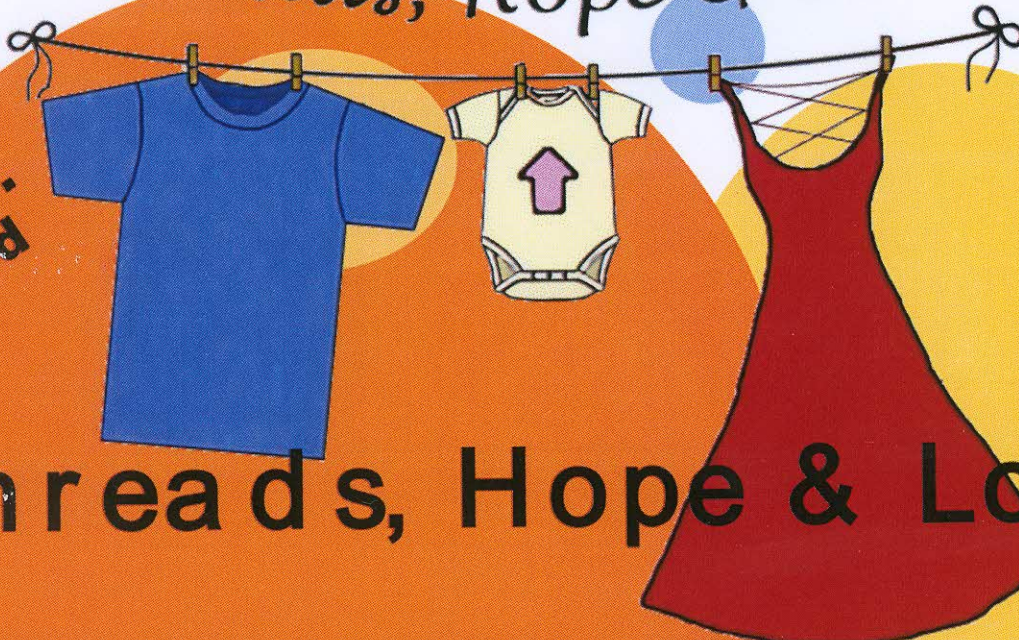
