Regular schedule for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year will be from **8:00 a.m. - 2:30 p.m.** This will still allow time for teachers to work with E-learners. Dismissal times will become **K-4 at 2:25 p.m.** and **Grades 5-8 at 2:30 p.m.** Buses will leave at 2:35 p.m. Students should remain in class until the 2:30 dismissal bell and then get ready to go home.

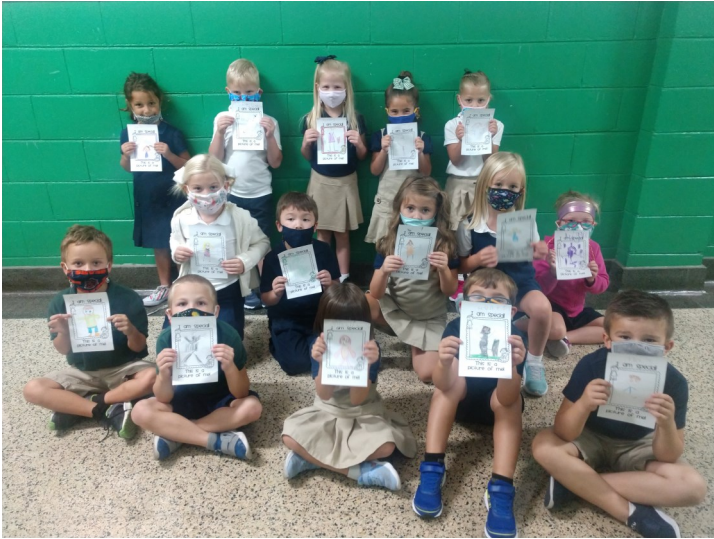
Parish Financial Update

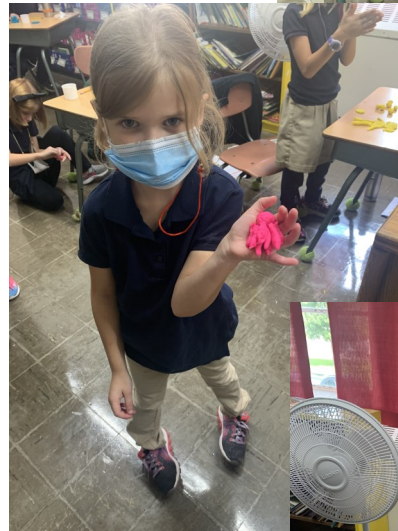
