## News from the Principal



#### Dear Parishioners and School Families, and Friends:

#### Your Help Is Needed!

**Invest in Kids Tax Credit Scholarship Program** has been in effect since 2018. They have awarded more than 37,000 scholarships totaling more than \$280 million. St. Patrick School has benefited from this program through Empower Illinois with a total of 42 students receiving scholarships totaling \$85,668.75 over the last five years. This year alone 15 students were awarded the need based scholarships totaling \$31,162.50 at St. Patrick School. Also, this year is the most scholarships awarded in the five years since the program began because we had funds available donated specifically to St. Patrick School. Thank you for your donations towards this program.

**Why we need your help!** The program must be renewed and made permanent. It must not be allowed to "sunset" or end. The Invest in Kids Act was passed in 2017 and has been proven successful with bipartisan voter support. Empower Illinois and the Tax Credit Scholarship Community have protected the program over the five years and even given an extension for one year, but now the program is scheduled to end in 2023 unless it is extended again or made permanent. 100% of the scholarships awarded are need based and are critically important for the continuance of these students attending our Catholic and private schools. The demand for this program remains higher than the available scholarships across Illinois, so we need your help (only 21% of the demand was met in 2021).
