Resilience

St. Patrick School participates in the Sports Leader Ministry Virtue=Strength program and each week study and put into practice a different virtue. This learning is applied not only in athletics, but also in the classroom. Recently, our school worked on the virtue "Resilience" which is the "strength to understand or recover quickly from difficult situations." As I was doing some research about this virtue, I came across some techniques to build resilience that are critical for children to learn in order for them to handle the uncertainty, challenges, and difficulties we all face throughout life. We all want our children to grow into well-adjusted and confident adults who can handle life's trials so learning skills such these necessary. From are gooddayswithkids.com/ here are steps to building resilience in your children I would like to share with

8 Ways to Build Resilience in Children:

- **1.**Let them experience disappointment so they can learn sadness doesn't last forever.
- **2.**Validate their fears and help them make plans to do things even if they're scared.
- **3.**Let them take (reasonable) risks and experience natural consequences.
- **4.**Encourage them to try new things, make mistakes, and learn from their mistakes.
- **5.**Give them opportunities to make their own decisions and help them problem solve.
- **6.**Tell stories of people who faced hard times, persisted, and grew stronger as a result.
- 7. Reframe challenges as short-term problems, and opportunities for learning.
- **8.**Remind them that although we can't control everything that happens to us, we can control how we respond.

Perhaps, this information will be useful to you in some way. I always like to include the importance of our faith in teaching children and having God as a part of our life as we help them learn and how to handle situations.

Did you Know?

Your child <u>can</u> attend a Catholic School Financial Assistance Available

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2021-2022 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from any Catholic elementary or secondary school in the Diocese of Peoria or on the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under *Catholic Education* and then under *Financial Assistance*. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: <u>online.factsmgt.com/aid</u>. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2021-2022 school year must reapply.

Deadline date for the completed application is **April 30, 2021.** Notification of grant awards will be made by the end of June 2021.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.
