5th—8th: 3:15pm

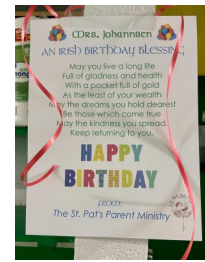


As of now, there will be Early Dismissal on Friday, September 24th at 11:30am due to WCHS Homecoming

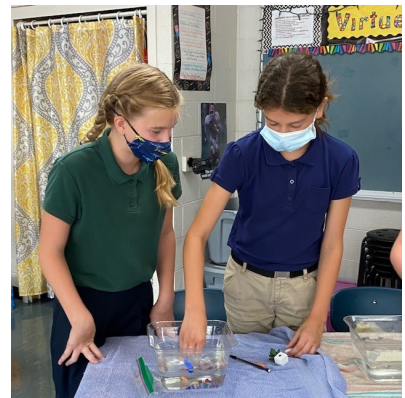
