### **SCIENCE IN ACTION**

Our 5th and 6th graders put their engineering skills to the test in an exciting hands-on STEM challenge! Working in teams, students were given a simple, yet tricky, task: build the tallest freestanding tower using only marshmallows.

This activity wasn't just about height, it was about creativity, collaboration, and critical thinking. Students brainstormed, tested, and reworked their designs, all while learning about basic engineering principles like structural stability and weight distribution.

There were some wobbly towers, some quick collapses, and a whole lot of laughter, but also some incredibly impressive results!



#### WHAT IS REVERENCE?

The strength to show love and respect to God and holy things.

Reverence means we love God and treat His house (the church), His name, and His special things (like the Bible or the cross) with care and quiet hearts.

#### **Examples of Reverence**

- **1. Genuflect Properly:** Face Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament and bring your knee all the way down to touch the floor and then make the sign of the cross slowly.
- **2. Appropriate Dress:** Dress modestly and appropriately for Mass or adoration. This reflects an understanding of the sacredness of the space and respect for God and fellow worshipers.
- **3. Participating Actively:** Join in responses, hymns, and prayers enthusiastically. Engaging in the liturgy shows respect for the community and the sacredness of the worship experience.





#### WHAT IS HUMILITY?

Humility is the strength to put God and others first instead of myself.

It is not about thinking less of ourselves, but thinking of ourselves less.

Humility is the strength to recognize our gifts and talents as blessings from God and to humbly acknowledge that we are not superior to others.

#### **Examples of Humility:**

- You let your friend go first in line, even if you really want to be first.
- You say "thank you" to God and your teacher for helping you instead of saying "I did it all by myself!"
- You help your classmate pick up papers they dropped without bragging about it or looking for praise.
