#### WHAT IS DETACHMENT?

The strength to let go of worldly desires and attachments in order to focus on the spiritual life.

This virtue enables us to prioritize our love for God above all else, trusting in Him fully, while being open to His will.

Detachment is not about rejecting the world but rather about having a proper perspective, recognizing that our ultimate fulfillment comes from God.

#### **Examples of Detachment:**

- 1. Maria chooses to spend her Saturday volunteering at a local shelter instead of sleeping in.
- 2. Carlos donates his old, unused electronics to charity even though they could bring in extra money.
- 3. Sarah refrains from obsessively checking social media, prioritizing family time and prayer to nurture her spiritual well-being.



#### THE VICE OF ATTACHMENT

The weakness to cling excessively to worldly possessions, people, or status to the point of prioritizing them over God.

Attachment can lead us to find our security, identity, and happiness in things or people rather than in God's will and can lead to idolatry.

#### **Examples of Attachment:**

- 1. Ethan refuses to part with his phone, even when it becomes a source of constant distraction from schoolwork and prayer, because he believes his happiness depends on knowing everything.
- 2. Lily constantly seeks approval from her friends by wearing expensive clothes, feeling empty when she's not at the center of attention.
- 3. Alex spends hours playing video games, neglecting his spiritual life and relationships with family because he is attached to the thrill of winning.







What is "The Elizabeth Ministry"? A facebook page for women to post prayer requests, post a meal sign up for families who have just had a baby or adopted, ask questions about pregnancy/pregnancy complications, adoption, being a foster parent, infertility, miscarriage, infant/child crisis or death, special needs, and grandparenting issues. You can post your questions or request prayers on our page and/or you can put a colored rose in our vase. We have 2 vases located on a table on the west wall of the church near our Mary statue. The vase on the left has an assortment of roses in different colors. Each color represents a prayer need. (YELLOW=infertility/adoption; PINK= pregnancy; RED= recently given birth or adopted; WHITE=miscarriage, stillborn, infant/child death; BLUE=troubling time; PURPLE=grandparent concerns) The drawer below this vase has prayer cards that correspond to each color intention. The vase on the right has roses with prayer cards attached. The prayer cards, string, scissors, and a pen can be found in the drawer below the right vase. You can fill out a prayer card and attach it to the color of the rose from the left vase and place it in the right vase. Meg Hatton sends an email and posts on our facebook page weekly of how we can pray for each other. Some ways we can support each other: Are you pregnant with twins and have questions? Contact Nicole, she has twins. Do you need a C-Section? Contact Meg, she has had 5 C-Sections. Have you had a miscarriage or know someone who has? Contact Theresa, she has had 2 miscarriages and has a prayer booklet with Bible verses and memorial ornament she can give you. Have you had an experience that you would be willing to support another woman in (ie: infertility, foster parent, adoption, pregnancy complications, etc.)? Please let Meg, Nicole, Shawn, or Theresa know! Would you like us to create a meal sign up due to bed rest from pregnancy complications, or newborn or adoption? Contact Nicole.
