

#### WHAT IS TEACHABILITY?

Teachability is the strength to remain open to learning and growth.

A teachable person is humble, receptive to feedback, and always seeks to improve, particularly in the light of God's teachings.

#### **Examples of Teachability:**

- 1. During a classroom discussion, a student listens intently to a peer's perspective, considering it thoughtfully even if it challenges their own point of view.
- 2. A student who struggles with a difficult subject asks a teacher or fellow student for clarification, demonstrating a desire to improve their understanding.
- A student makes an honest admission when they've misunderstood a concept, and works diligently to correct their errors with the guidance of a teacher or mentor.

#### WHAT IS FORTITUDE?

The virtue of Fortitude, or Courage, is the strength to do the right thing in the face of fear and/or difficulties.

It is strength in adversity. Fortitude is having courage and strength to do what is right, even when it's hard or scary. It's trusting that God is always with us.

#### **Examples of Fortitude:**

- 1. A student chooses to pray in public or share their faith even when they know it might be unpopular.
- 2. In a society where immodesty is prevalent, Catholics can demonstrate fortitude by choosing to dress modestly, even though everyone else continues otherwise.
- 3. When confronted with anti-Catholic views, a Catholic can exhibit fortitude by engaging in respectful, informed discussions that articulate the position of Truth. This requires courage to confront misunderstandings and misinformation while maintaining compassion for those who disagree.




